Year 2022-23 was an action-packed year I must say. There was excitement, lots of new learnings, plenty of risks and yet, an undying passion to serve and contribute to special needs. Our vocational skills and employment unit (a dream come true project) had finally kicked off and we grew manifold as a team. Our education and rehabilitation work in Gubbi consolidated even more and parents started flocking our centre with their children in huge numbers. It is with a lot of pride I say that we have been able to effectively impact more than 400 students. Even our Sundays are packed with more than 30 children availing physiotherapy services in Gubbi.

While in Bengaluru our education was in news for NIOS pass outs, and our vocational skills took off to a flying start. Our Bengaluru centre saw some exciting work, with block printing and other art forms introduced. Students at our centre learnt stitching, small crochet and embroidery work, and by the end of August, almost all our students were able to independently block print. Seeing them come on holiday too to execute corporate orders was amazing. At this time, we realized the importance of having in-house tailors and to our luck, some of the mothers of our students at Gubbi were highly skilled tailors. Without any delay, we onboarded the parents of our children. With the help of well-wishers and donors, we help of well-wishers and donors, we were able to set up a fullfledged tailoring unit at Gubbi, providing employment to 15 mothers of our special needs children. This was a big leap for us, as this led us to set up our own brand 'Aase' (Special Minds Dream, Special Hands Create), a product line for Chiranthana.

Another milestone for us happened in November 2022, when we moved to bigger premises which have a full-fledged physiotherapy room, computer lab, yoga hall, hall for vocational skills and classrooms. We are very excited to be launching AASE retail shop too at this centre.

It is a big challenge to sustain in a social space, that too one of this nature. We are looking for opportunities to grow and scale this so our artists can continue earning and thriving.

2022-23, not everything was easy and peaceful. With growth also comes obstacles. We made plenty of mistakes, failed many times, were demotivated, some students and teachers left us, and some losses we incurred, but at the end of it all - we survived. We survived because we stayed curious, were and are willing to learn, looked at each day with new enthusiasm and spirit and most importantly – stayed most importantly – we stay interested!

ABOUT CHIRANTHANA:

Chiranthana is a not-for-profit organisation working with people with special needs. We work with people with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, Down Syndrome and other learning disabilities.

We have already engaged a lot of people with disabilities in creating handicraft products. Chiranthana is working in the segment of intellectual disabilities. We are currently working with children and adolescents with special needs. Chiranthana is working with special needs people with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Downs Syndrome, Dyslexia, locomotor disabilities communication disorders

We enable special needs persons through education, rehabilitation and employment by working with parents, organisations, teachers and the government.






OUR PROGRAMS

EDUCATION

Chiranthana provides education facilities at the Elementary, Secondary, and Senior secondary levels for people with special needs, both in Bengaluru and Gubbi. We also operate from a "Model Centre" at the Block Resource Center in Gubbi along with school readiness centres at different clusters of Gubbi.





- Interactive classroom set-up is being used to learn new things.
- Students are learning functional skills are learnt through audio-visual inputs.
- Students have been taught computer skills and numeracy skills.
- Behavioural skills taught through social stories and audiovisual learning devices
- Socio-emotional skills & life skills are taught through various activities.
- Chiranthana's students, Sanket, Nisarga, Prutha passed their NIOS exams with flying colours in November 2022.



REHABILITATION:

Impact on 350 + students in Gubbi and Bangalore

Chiranthana Bangalore acts as the nodal centre for all branches and projects. We moved into new premises in the month of November. We were able to establish Class rooms, physiotherapy room, computer lab, class rooms, yoga and theatre room. The new facility is well equipped to teach and train people with intellectual disabilities.

Children at Chiranthana are provided individual attention and Individual education plans are designed to ensure better learning and also to help develop the inherent abilities of special needs children.





Chiranthana provides physiotherapy sessions to people with special needs both at the Bangalore centre as well as Gubbi. We have set up a physio station at both centres. Physiotherapy sessions are used as a tool of intervention to help improve the functional abilities of a child with special needs. These sessions are a part of the rehabilitation program run by Chiranthana.







YOGA

Chiranthana conducts yoga classes for people with special needs. Children are learning surya namaskar and many other yogasanas. They are also being taught meditation, which is beneficial to their mental and physical well-being.







EMPLOYMENT::

Chiranthana is working towards providing employment opportunities for people with special needs. Our Artisanship training for people with special needs is helping them lead independent lives as they are provided with employment at Chiranthana as per their skills and abilities.





15+ mothers of special children have been empowered at the Vocational skills centre in Gubbi

We were able to start the vocational skills centre at Gubbi and set up tailoring machines and train people on tailoring, macrame and hand block printing. At the vocational skills centre in Gubbi, we have employed mothers of special needs children resulting in better economic stability through income generation and the children are able to come to the school readiness center and learn various skills, this has resulted in a win win situation for all the stakeholders.



Growing with Chiranthana

I am Ravi and I joined Chiranthana in August 2022. My son is a special child and he could not read and write, but ever since he has joined Chiranthana, he has improved, he can read and write and communicate better. My wife and I joined the vocational skills center run by Chiranthana and our lives changed. I am grateful to Chiranthana for having provided the training for making macrame products and also for providing an opportunity to my wife and me to work at the vocational skills center and earn a living.


